Course Description

Instruction focuses on reading comprehension, writing fluency, and vocabulary study through the use of various literary and informational texts. Students enrolled in the course will engage in text-based discussions, create text-based questions, and complete research. They will write in response to reading and cite evidence when answering text dependent questions orally and in writing. The course provides extensive opportunities for students to collaborate with their peers.

Makeup Work Policy

Students who are submitting late work (due to absence) should have one day, or one day for each day absent (whichever is greater), to submit work unless the teacher determines there are extenuating circumstances which necessitate an extension, or a school-wide policy exists that grants additional time. Students will receive an "X" (Excused) in the gradebook only when they were absent when the assignment was completed or due. An "X" is not worth any points and will not influence the student's average grade. Students will receive an "M" (Missing) in the gradebook only when they have been given an opportunity to complete an assignment but has yet to turn it in. An "M" is considered a zero and will influence the student's average grade. It is the responsibility of students to obtain and complete any missing work within the expected time frame. **NOTE:** Grades will be updated at least once a week.

Attendance – The following procedure is a school-wide policy:
